'Be strong and courageous..'

Those immortal words from Joshua 1:9 echoed across 6 weeks of amazing, gospel-sharing ministry in Venezuela this summer. Our team of 7 students (3 returners) and 2 staff shared with over 400 students, taxi drivers, store owners, parents, etc. about how to begin a relationship with Jesus. Over 30 indicated decisions for Christ, most of whom we were able to personally invest in and disciple during the remainder of our time there. God certainly went before us!

Never underestimate the power of personal relationships in evangelism! Urbe, a campus where I spent a significant amount of time, is attended by some of the wealthiest students in the city. Plagued with spiritual apathy because of their over-contentedness, we struggled to find students willing to hear or accept the gospel message there. After nearly four weeks of evangelism and realizing our

time was coming to an end I and returner, Matt, prayed that God would multiply our efforts and lead us to the right people. As soon as we opened our eyes God led us to Christopher. Christopher introduced us to his friend, Lenny. While we were talking Lenny's friend Carlos approached us. Even though he wasn't interested in spiritual things, he called his friend Victor over who just recently started following Jesus! And Victor was God's direct answer to Matt and I's prayers! I spent the next few days discipling him; he was so hungry we covered half a semester's material in less than a week! Now he is connected with Vida Estudiantil (Cru in VZ) and actively reaching his campus!

So to lift his spirits we went for an upscale Venezuelan birthday dinner. At dinner a Vida student leader, Jose Angel, stood and thanked Tyler for his leap of faith, understanding the sacrifice of no family around for his birthday, "I want you to know that you always have a family here." Tyler was clearly moved. When we arrived home he really wanted to return. What a beautiful picture of the gospel uniting people!

We decided to focus one recent study on how to share the gospel. We walked them through the Souldarium (beginning spiritual conversations through pictures) and

the 4 Spiritual Laws, and at the end encouraged the guys to pair up sometime during the week to share around campus.

Mere hours after parting ways Alex, a transfer student from Mt Aloysius, met Nichole who seemed pretty distressed. He thought she would be just the kind of person who needed the gospel, so he brought out the 4 Spiritual Laws booklet he just learned how to use and went through it with her. She was an atheist, so he was nervous to

question her to a point of decision; but before he could get there though she blurted out, "Well after this I guess I'm a Christian now!" (As Alex related the story all the guys in the study cheered and clapped!) I was reminded that amazing knowledge or convincing arguments aren't nearly as effective as just sharing the person and message of Jesus. How exciting!

Cross Pollinating in Johnstown

You may remember Justin, our solid student leader from Penn Highlands Community College in Johnstown. Since last year he has run for and won the Student President position and built relationships with several of the college's faculty, staff and student club leaders! (Wow!) A brand new wave of students are now exploring Cru and coming on a regular basis.

After recently returning from our annual Fall Retreat a new sense of ownership and passion to share the gospel seems



They heard at the Fall Retreat about the priority of the lost hearing the gospel, so during the weekly meeting we went across the street to Pitt Johnstown (UPJ), partnered up with a ministry there called Timeout and shared our faith. We collected over a hundred survey cards of UPJ students expressing interest in discussing the message of Jesus or attending a Bible study (which are the beautiful seeds of a budding spiritual movement on campus)!

Cru may be most well known for the creation of the simple, streamlined gospel-sharing tool, the Four Spiritual Laws authored by Bill Bright back in the 50's. As the culture has shifted Cru continues to grow and adapt with an aim that everyone can respond to the unchanging truth of the Good News of Jesus in a clear and understandable way. It is from this desire the Soularium cards were born!

student after student respond openly to this strategically compiled deck of images. We ask them a series of questions ('What's a picture that represents your life now? Your view of God? Your view of Jesus' message?'), to which, the answers are pictures. While non-believers respond well to the cards, our students also love using them (double win)! This has been a primary tool in beginning gospel focused conversations where non-believers, sometimes for the first time, are able to express and address their obstacles to a life-changing relationship with Jesus.

I'm Getting Married!
