“How crazy is it that you came into my store today.. me feeling distant from God.. and then you sharing that message...” She continued, “I love my life. I have a great husband, kid, this store that I love... sometimes you can have everything and still feel like you have nothing.”

“I have never done anything like this before,” Queens College freshman, Aniska, explained as they walked out into the streets of Baltimore at Cru’s Winter Conference.

After hearing some incredible messages at the conference students were venturing into the city trusting God to lead them to spiritually open people. That’s how Aniska and Ashley paired up, surveys in hand. They walked into a shop and quickly met Jenee, the owner, who was kind enough to answer their questions. She mentioned having grown up in Baltimore and loving it. As the conversation progressed she added, ‘I have felt distant from God... even though I grew up going to church.’

Abruptly, two customers walked in, triggering the end of their conversation. As Jenee wiped away tears, Aniska quietly handed her the booklet to keep and they left the store. And that would have been the end.

But a few minutes later, Aniska wanted to go back inside! ‘I felt like we left in a rush.’ Just as quickly they walked back in, apologized for the abrupt end and asked if they could pray for her. Eager to care for this woman, Aniska offered her hand to hold as she prayed for her new friend.

Aniska shared afterward how her pastor talks about people longing to know God, but it never really felt true until that moment, in a real encounter. What a great first encounter!
